"I have always found joy in making. Craft reminds us to stop, take time, think, make and listen. You can't rush the materials you work with, the tools you use, the process you're using. There will always be an added value, an element of luxury, within a handmade object that can never be achieved with mass-produced methods."

Rosie works with various materials, often using a combination of traditional handcrafting skills and luxurious and fragile materials. Contradicting functionality, and exploring the conflicts between craft & mass-production, luxury & necessity are reoccurring themes in Rosie's work.

Rosie has exhibited at Mint, Kensington, at the Kath Libbert Jewellery Gallery, Saltaire and the New Art Exchange, Nottingham. Her graduate collection *Impotent Tools* was purchased by a significant private collector and Crafts Council Trustee.
